






### **Qatar Digital Library Content**

- Over 17,000 digitized items
  - Mostly from collections of the British Library
  - 147 from Qatar National Library collections
  - More content coming in 2020 (e.g. Gulf Architecture Project)

- Increased access, openness and free re-use (at least for non-commercial purposes)
- Access through many platforms, metadata on CCO license
- Professional digitization and long-term digital preservation
- Bi-directional knowledge transfer and transparency

# Electronic Resources Licensing Principles (Copyright Related)

- Access to all authorized users
- 'Unrestricted' use (classroom, coursepack, interlibrary loan, text & data mining, visually impaired)
- Rights of users under national copyright law shall not be restricted by agreement
- Agreements allow Qatar based researchers to publisher open access articles









#### **Objectives of the fund**

 to cover open access publishing costs for Qatar-based researchers

 to create and contribute to the permanent archive of Qatar-based research at the Library.



### Increase in open access adoption in Qatar



### How often did our respondents use the fund?






Total respondents of survey


Used the fund at least once
