CC Lisences

- » **CC 0 (CC zero)**– waiver of copyright; no rights reserved. Places content as openly as possible in the public domain.
- » **CC Attribution (BY)** – a license clause that allows the reuse, sharing, and remixing of materials providing the original author is appropriately attributed.
- » **CC ShareAlike (SA)** – a license clause requiring that derivative works have the same license as the original.

CC Lisences

- » **CC NonCommercial (NC)** – a license clause allowing the reuse, sharing, and remixing of materials providing that it is not for commercial purposes.
- » **CC NoDerivatives (ND)** – a license clause requiring that derivatives are not made of the original works.
